A very attractive pillowy 1-finger head. Some lacing on the side of the glass. Low to medium carbonation, perfect for a porter. Dark brown clean appearance. Unfortunately, the head fades quickly.

Aromas of roasted and toasted malts. A light toffee and bready notes as well. Some floral and citrus hops characters are present.

Flavour

Flavor: Fruity, Citrus, Tropical, Juicy, Piney, Resonous, Floral, Spicy, Herbal, Earthy, Woody, Funky, Sour, etc.

Hop Bitterness: Mild, Moderate, Aggressive, Harsh

Malt: Grainy, Biscuit, Bready, Roasty, Toasty, Caramel, Toffey, Chocolate, Coffee, etc.

Just like the nose, the roasty, toasty malts dominate. These are balanced with a sweet toffee flavor. The hops are a little more pronounced than I prefer for a Porter. Tastes like floral noble hops and grapefruit. It's still a porter, but edges toward a black IPA for me. Still, a very tasty beer!
